

## UCM HIGH SCHOOL ART CONTEST DAY

The UCM Art Contest is an event where art students come to the UCM Campus and create artwork on-site that will be judged for artistic merit or participate in non-competitive workshops. Contest Day activities will begin **Friday, April 1, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.**

In order for students to take part in the contest, they must pre-register by **Friday, March 18, 2022**. Each contestant or school is responsible for bringing necessary working materials. Schools will be contacted by mail as to where the students are to report. The entry fee is **\$2.00** per student and fees must be sent to the art office after online registration has been completed (teachers may also pay for students on site if they have been registered for the event by **March 18**. Checks should be made payable to the University of Central Missouri and mailed to the address shown at the end of this form. Registration for the Art Contest Day will happen online beginning **Tuesday February 1**, (see website at <http://www.ucmo.edu/art/> under the "High School Art Exhibit and Contest" tab).

TENTATIVE CONTEST ACTIVITIES: Contest areas will be open 9:00 am to 11:00 am. Contest areas will be closed from 11:00 to 12:00 for judging, except where indicated.

### Juried Competition

<b>Drawing - Still life</b> Bring paper/drawing board/drawing mediums	Limit of 60
<b>Drawing – Model</b> Bring paper/drawing boards/drawing mediums	Limit of 15
<b>Painting/Drawing - City/Landscape</b> Bring paper or painting supplies/drawing mediums	No limit
<b>Painting - Still life</b> Bring all painting supplies and surface to paint on (watercolor or acrylics only)	Limit 15
<b>2D Design</b> Bring black markers (felt tip pens), heavy drawing paper (i.e. Bristol board)	Limit of 15
<b>Fibers - Soft Sculpture</b> Bring fabric, yarn, beads, sharp scissors, etc. (no kits)	Limit of 15
